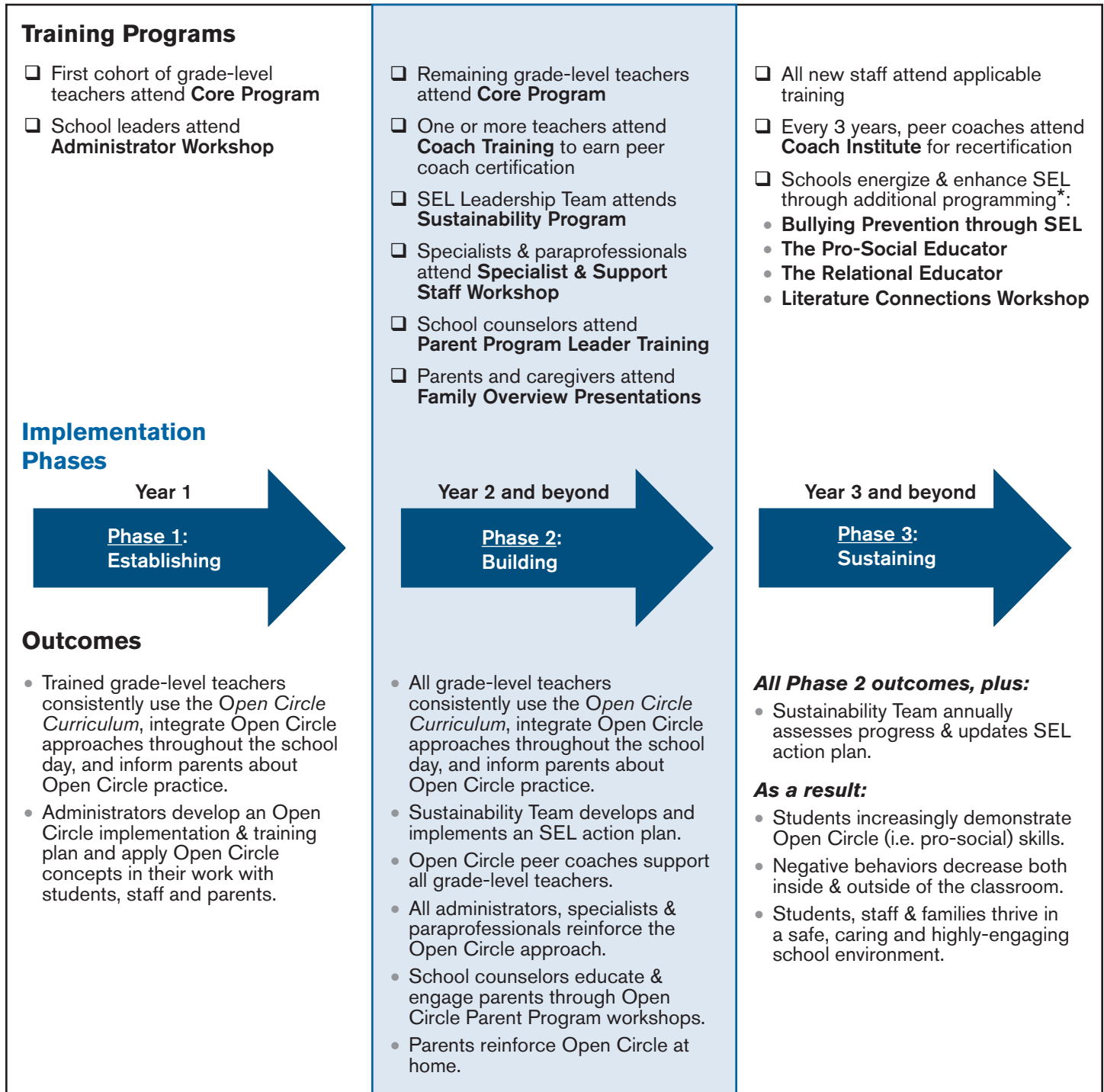


Implementation Model

The following diagram illustrates our recommended implementation model; however, implementation plans and timelines can vary. We will work together to customize a plan that meets your school's needs.



*Many of these additional programs can also be implemented at earlier phases.

Programs Overview

Develop *in-school leadership* for SEL through two unique programs:

- **Coach Training:** A year-long program that trains educators to provide the coaching component of Open Circle's Core Program to their peers and to become leaders for social and emotional learning in their schools.
- **Sustainability Program:** A year-long program helping multi-departmental teams develop and launch customized plans to broaden, deepen, and sustain Open Circle in their schools.

Engage families through programs and materials:

- **Home Links:** Letters communicating weekly Open Circle lessons and ideas for infusion at home (in English and Spanish).
- **Family Overviews:** Presentations to introduce Open Circle concepts, approaches, and vocabulary to your parent community.
- **Parent Program:** Parent workshop series led by a school staff member to facilitate deeper learning about using Open Circle approaches at home.

High-quality professional development is critical to the success of any new educational program or curriculum. Open Circle provides a comprehensive array of hands-on, experiential professional development programs for all members of your school community.

Open Circle's primary training programs are tailored to the specific roles of different school staff member:

- **Core Program:** A year-long program required for grade-level teachers to implement the *Open Circle Curriculum* in their classrooms. Includes four training days and two classroom visits.
- **Administrator Workshop:** A one-day workshop providing an understanding of Open Circle concepts, approaches and vocabulary, and exploring how school leaders can best support social and emotional learning in their schools.
- **Specialist and Support Staff Workshop:** A one-day workshop introducing key Open Circle approaches and vocabulary, and exploring how specialists and support staff can infuse Open Circle concepts throughout the school day and use Open Circle approaches to enhance their own work.
- **Parent Program Leader Training:** A three-session program training school counselors to lead Open Circle's Parent Program, a workshop series helping parents and caregivers learn to infuse Open Circle concepts, approaches and vocabulary at home.

Additional programs offer opportunities to improve school climate and hone social and emotional teaching and facilitation skills:

- **Bullying Prevention through SEL:** A year-long program that helps schools strengthen their strategy for preventing and addressing bullying through research, analysis, planning, and implementation of enhancements and additions to their existing work with Open Circle.
- **The Pro-Social Educator:** A workshop series that explores how enhancing educators' social and emotional competency can increase their engagement in teaching, strengthen their relationships with students, and improve their stress management, all of which lead to improved student outcomes.
- **The Relational Educator:** A workshop series that explores how enhancing adult relationships in schools – including trust, communication, and collaboration – can improve overall school climate and student outcomes.
- **Literature Connections Workshop:** A half-day workshop that explores ways to teach and reinforce social and emotional learning concepts through the study of high-quality children's literature.
